Erin Overturf joined WRA in 2013. Previously, she served as an Assistant Solicitor General in the Office of the Colorado Attorney General. In that capacity, she represented state agencies such as the Colorado Public Utilities Commission, the Colorado Air Pollution Control Division, and the Colorado Energy Office. She also served as a clerk to Justice Alex Martinez of the Colorado Supreme Court.

Erin oversees the work of WRA's Clean Energy Program in Colorado and Nevada. Erin assists in the development of WRA's policy and legal advocacy positions, with the goal of decarbonizing the electricity sector and utilizing clean electricity to fuel other end-uses that have traditionally been powered by fossil fuels, such as transportation and residential and commercial buildings. Erin and her team represent WRA in utility regulatory proceedings, air quality proceedings, negotiations, and civil litigation.

Erin holds a J.D. from the American University Washington College of Law, and received a B.A. in both Economics and Anthropology from the University of Colorado at Boulder.
